SAFE, BY BIKE!
 Since July 2010, the Rules of the Road have introduced the obligation of wearing reflecting jackets or suspenders when circulating AT NIGHT OUTSIDE POPULATED AREAS or in all galleries (including those in populated areas).
 The Province of Lodi also highly advises people riding a bike to use a helmet, even if the law does not oblige cyclists to use it.

 This is a portal where all the cycling paths of lower Lombardy can be found. These cover about 2000 kilometres consisting of entirely flat paths distant from the traffic, of country roads, of secondary roads and of cycling paths.
 This network offers a wide range of possibilities for trips, from "ring" itineraries only a few kilometres long to longest tours lasting for more days. There also are roadbooks, images and some useful information.

1. Proceed eastbound on Viale Enrico Forlanini/SP15b
2. Enter the Tangenziale est (Eastern ringroad) through the junction from **Bologna/Tangenziale Ovest (Western ringroad)/Genova/Torino/Varese/Como**
3. Proceed on A1 (follow directions for **Tangenziale Ovest/Bologna**)
4. Exit at Lodi
 OR
5. Exit a Casalpusterlengo
 OR
6. Exit at Guardamiglio/Piacenza Nord

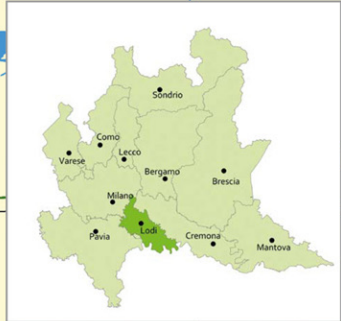

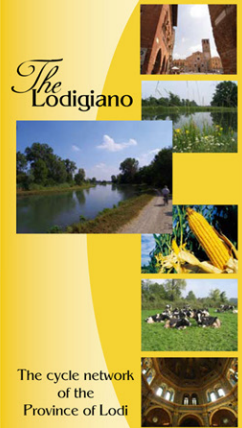
